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# Annamalai University

In the early 1920s Rajah Sir S. R. M. Annamalai Chettiar founded Sri Minakshi College, Sri Minakshi Tamil College and Sri Minakshi Sanskrit College at Chidambaram. In 1928, Rajah Sir S.R.M. Annamalai Chettiar agreed with the local Government to handover the above said institution for establishing a University. Thus, on 01.01.1929 Annamalai University was established as per Annamalai University Act 1928 (Tamil Nadu Act 1 of 1929).

“**The NIRF-2020**” by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) has ranked the University in the band 101 - 150 in the University Category. In the Pharmacy Category the ranking is 12th in India. In the Medical Category the ranking is 35th.

“**The Times Higher Education World University Ranking - 2020**” has ranked Annamalai University in 1000+ for Overall category. In the Subject category Ranking, 2020, the University is ranked in the band of 501-600 for Life Sciences and 600+ for Pre-clinical, clinical & Health Subjects. 800+ in the Physical Sciences and Engineering subject.

“**The QS World University Ranking - 2020**” has ranked Annamalai University in the band of 291 - 300 in Asia Ranking and 39 in India Ranking.

“**The CWTS Leiden Ranking 2019** has ranked the University at 23rd based on the number of publications and 7th based on the proportion of publications.

The **SCImago Institutional Ranking** (2019) has ranked 9th in Tamil Nadu and 29th among the top 212 ranked institutions for Higher Education in India. **International Comparative Performance of India's Research Base** (2009-14) has rated the University as the top Indian Institute in Pharmacology, 17th among the top 30 Indian Universities in Publications. The **Global Exposure, Indian Science Ascending**, has ranked the University as 11th among the top 20 Indian Institutions in International Collaborations.

Annamalai University is one of the largest unitary, teaching, and residential Universities in Southern Asia comprising of 10 Faculties and 49 departments of study. This University has played a pivotal role in providing access to higher education to thousands of youth cutting across the social spectrum, especially from economically and socially disadvantaged classes. In this respect, this University's service to the nation is tremendous.

The University Library, named after the eminent scholar, statesman and former Vice-Chancellor Dr. Sir C.P. Ramaswami Aiyer, serves as knowledge hub for the students and the staff. The sports complex of the University spreads over several acres, houses facilities for sports and games. 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## 1. Faculty of Dentistry

The RAJAH MUTHIAH DENTAL COLLEGE was established in the year 1980 as a part of Rajah Muthiah Institute of Health Sciences (RMIHS) The institute was subsequently expanded by starting a Medical College. His Excellency Shri. R. Venkataraman, the then President of India visited the RMIHS on 28.04.1998 and declared open the building presently housing the Dental College and Medical College

Adequate hostel facilities for boys and girls students, staff-quarters and other amenities have been provided in the campus. The Institute celebrated its Silver Jubilee in November 2005.

Adequate infrastructure required for training Post Graduate as well as Under Graduate students are available in the Institute. Out-patient and in-patient facilities are provided including a modern and well equipped operation theatre.

The Rajah Muthiah Dental College & Hospital has excellent infrastructural facilities reflecting the latest developments in Dentistry including an imported casting and ceramic Laboratory. Recently, the Dental College has upgraded its infrastructure by adding the following facilities.

- New block for specialities in Orthodontics and Periodontics.
- Two well equipped A/C Lecture Halls with a capacity for 250 persons.
- R.V.G. System and Intra-oral camera facilities.
- Teseera ATL composite crown and bridge system.
- Vector unit for Periodontal treatment.
- A complete VIP clinic with latest state-of-art Technologies.
- Centrally Air conditioned Library with separate Post Graduate and staff sections.
- A latest, fully equipped Mobile Dental Clinic with two Dental chairs for Rural Dental Camps and School Camps routinely conducted by the Division of Community Dentistry
- A full fledged IMPLANT CLINIC with a complete set of latest equipments and 3 internationally renowned Implant systems available for implant treatment.

The hospital is well equipped with sufficient number of state-of-the-art Dental chairs and other latest equipment enabling provision of modern dental care to a large number of patients. The hospital also organises routine Dental Camps with a fully equipped mobile clinic in the surrounding villages. .

A special feature of Rajah Muthiah Dental College & Hospital is that, it is one of the very few Dental Colleges in India directly run by Universities. As a University Dental College with residential system, there are ample opportunities for healthy interaction and

learning from multi-disciplinary facilities available on the campus of Annamalai University. Situated in sylvan surroundings, the University is in close proximity to the famous pilgrim centre of Chidambaram.

Besides BDS, Post Graduate degree programmes in 8 different specialities are being offered by the Rajah Muthiah Dental College and Hospital. All these programmes are recognised by Dental Council of India.

#### 3.2 Hostel Fee

After admission, the students are advised to visit the respective hostel office for completing formalities related to hostel.

#### 3.3 Scholarships

The students of Annamalai University can avail the Government Scholarships subject to eligibility.

- i. **Applicable to only candidates selected through selection committee, Directorate of Medical Education.**
- ii. **Post Matric Scholarship:** In the G.O. (st) No. 6 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 09.01.2012, G.O. (st) No.92 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 11.09.2012 and G.O. (st) No.16 Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare (AD3) Department dated 24.02.2014, the Government has ordered to grant Post Matric Scholarship to SC/SCA/ST candidates, whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 2,50,000/- (Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand) and for SC/SCA converted Christians whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two Lakhs) from all the sources. The eligible candidates have to submit income certificate obtained from appropriate authorities.

- iii. **Higher Education Special Scholarship:** Higher Education Special Scholarship is awarded to the hostel students belonging to SC / SCA / ST and Converted Christian categories. The Annual income from all sources should not exceed Rs 2,00,000/- (Two Lakhs) per annum.
- iv. An **Equal Opportunity Cell** and an **SC/ST Cell** is functioning in the University to assist the students in availing the Scholarships, besides carrying out various other activities for the benefit of the students. Students may approach these Cells for further details and assistance for Scholarship related matters.

**Note: For all Scholarships income certificate obtained after April 2020 should be produced.**

#### 4. Method of Selection

Candidates who are interested in joining these courses at Rajah Muthiah Dental College, Annamalai University, for the academic year 2020-2021 must have secured the minimum qualification score in **National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET)** held on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020 conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. The candidates should apply and also appear for the counselling to be conducted by the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu, Kilpauk, Chennai, the dates of which will be announced by the Selection Committee. #### 5. Security Bond

- i. **Candidates selected for admission and his/her Parent / Guardian will have to execute an Agreement Bond during admission to college as prescribed in Annexure-I. Failure to execute the Agreement Bond will lead to cancellation of Selection.**
- ii. **The seat vacated/resigned by the Candidate on re-allocation and subsequently if the seat is filled before the last date of admission as directed by the DCI is Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) (Service Charges).**
- iii. **The seat vacated / resigned by the Candidate after counselling period and the seat is not filled before the last date of admission as directed by the DCI is Rs. 15,89,370/- (Bond breakage fee Rs. 3,00,000/- + First Year fee Rs. 3,50,370/- + remaining fee for the entire programme Rs. 9,39,000/-)**
- iv. **Penalty, in case candidates resigns after final round of AIQ / State Counselling is Rs. 15,89,370/- (Bond breakage fee Rs. 3,00,000/- + First Year fee Rs. 3,50,370/- + remaining fee for the entire programme Rs. 9,39,000/-)**

## **6. General Instruction to Applicants/Selected Candidates for B.D.S. Degree Programme**

1. The candidates are informed that ragging in any form is totally banned/prohibited and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. Attention of the candidates is invited to the Notification of the Regulations 2009 issued by the Dental Council of India in this regard. The students are required to give an undertaking at the time of admission.
2. In case of students who have joined the Programme of study but discontinued the programme on subsequent reallocation by the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Tamil Nadu, Kilpauk, Chennai to other College, the amount remitted by the candidate will be refunded after deducting the service charges of ` 10,000/- (Ten thousand only).
3. With regard to any dispute arising in relation to admission, examinations, remittance of fees, etc., the place of jurisdiction for the purpose of filing a suit or preferring a complaint or taking any legal proceedings against the Annamalai University, will be Chidambaram Town only.
4. No certificate will be issued, unless the candidate has cleared all the arrears of fees etc., from the University.
5. All the candidates selected for the admission for the Annamalai University has to execute a bond as detailed in Section 5 (page no. 16) of this prospectus in the format prescribed by the University before admission to Course Compulsorily. (Format is available on University Website: [www.annamalaiuniversity.in](http://www.annamalaiuniversity.in)).
6. Tuition fee for each academic year should be paid well before the due date, failing which a fine as prescribed by the University will be charged. The Candidate shall not be permitted to appear for the University Examination without clearing the Tuition fee arrears.
7. Caution deposit shall be refunded on application after adjustment towards any dues from the student. Application for refund of caution deposit should be submitted within one year of completing the course.
8. Original Certificates submitted at the time of admission are not returnable till the end of the Programme. Before the certificates are surrendered for admission, the candidates are advised to have with them attested copies of mark lists or other certificates that may be required for applying scholarships etc.

## 7. Code of Conduct

The following code of conduct shall be observed by the students who are admitted.

- i. The students should conduct themselves in an exemplary manner so as to be a model for other students.
- ii. All students will have to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the University.
- iii. **RAGGING:** The candidates should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging. If they are found to have indulged in ragging in the past or noticed later, the candidates will be removed from the roll of the institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against the candidates.
- iv. **If any student is involved in ragging or any other anti-social activities, he/she will be expelled and criminal proceedings may be launched against him/her.**
- v. The students should be present during all working days and sincerely apply themselves to studies.
- vi. The students should attend the classes regularly and punctually and should fulfil the attendance requirement as prescribed by the Dental Council of India to be eligible to appear for the University Examinations.
- vii. The campus is "Tobacco Free" and "Liquor Free". Any violation of this will result in dismissal from the programme.
- viii. Use of mobile phones and other electronic gadgets is not permitted in the class rooms, examination halls, faculty premises, university organized functions/ programs / extracurricular and co-curricular activities.
- ix. The students are forbidden from using motorized vehicles, including powered two wheelers, inside the campus.
- x. **Dress Code:** Students need to wear formal dress largely covering them like Sarees/ Churidhar with dupatta for girls and Trousers, Pant & Shirt for boys.

## 8. General Information

The following procedures should be followed for applying / getting certificates viz. Bonafide/Course completion/Mark lists etc. with the fee prescribed by the University.

- i. **General:** Mark list for each Semester/Year during the period of study will be issued by the University and distributed through the respective department of study. On completion of the programme, Provisional Certificate and Transfer Certificate will also be distributed through the department concerned.
- ii. **Migration Certificate:** This certificate will be issued by the University Office ('K' Section) only on demand to those who have planned to undergo higher studies in any Educational Institution in India.



- iii. **Duplicate Certificate– Mark List / Degree / Transfer Certificate:** A certificate from the police department is required to be produced for the loss of certificates indicating that the certificates were actually lost beyond recovery.
- iv. **Degree Certificate:** Notification will be issued in the leading dailies during the month of September/October every year for calling of application forms for getting Degree Certificate at the Convocation. Students shall apply for the same in the prescribed form which can be obtained from the University.
- v. **Personal File:** Students are advised to maintain a personal file containing all academic records such as challan for remittance of tuition fee, exam fee, instrument fee, condonation fee etc. till completion of his/her studies.
- vi. **Re-admission:** If any attendance deficiency during the tenure of his/her studies, shall apply for re-admission through the Heads concerned along with the photocopy of his/her previous semester/year mark list/s as proof for having appeared for the University Examinations.
- vii. **Change of Name/Date of Birth:** Candidate who wish to change Name, date of Birth, of his/her name should be made only during the period of study by producing a copy of "Gazette Notification" from the respective Government. No such change shall be entertained after completion for his studies in the University.
- viii. **How to get Certificate:**
  - a. Students applied for any certificates in this University viz., Duplicate mark list, Degree Certificate and Transfer Certificate etc, either during the tenure of his/her studies or completion of the programme should get the same from the office or by post within a fortnight period from the date of filing application in the office. He/she should possess compulsorily **1)** a copy of letter where he/she has applied for **2)** a copy of remittance challan, **3)** and any other documents etc., whenever any lapse of the original submitted to University (or) loss in transaction.
  - b. If he/she does not receive the certificate/s within the stipulated period, then he/she can immediately seek the assistance of the Section Head/Deputy Registrar of the 'K' Section with relevant copy of records that has been already submitted for claiming the certificates, so as to enable them to get the certificate from the office (or) necessary guidance will be provided for the same.
  - c. Students admitted on various programs of the University, should get back his/her original certificates produced at the time of admission within three months either on completion of programme (or) discontinuing the same in the middle of the programme. The University is not responsible for any lapse or damage of the certificates.

WHEREAS the candidate has, on his/her application been selected to undergo training for the B.D.S. Course in the Rajah Muthiah Dental College and Hospital (hereinafter referred to as the said College).

AND WHEREAS the candidate has agreed to complete his/her training for the said course, at the said College, subject to the condition hereinafter appearing.

Now THEREFORE, this agreement witnesses and it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. The candidate shall diligently complete his/her training for the said course at the said College, shall abide by the rules of the said College for the time being in force regulating the conduct of students at the said College and shall pass all the examinations prescribed for the said Course by the University or the Dental Institution concerned.
2. Upon passing the final B.D.S. Examination the candidate shall serve as 'Intern' for the prescribed period as laid down by the Dental Council Act, (Section 20 of Dentist Act 1948).
3. During the period of Internship under clause (2) and while in service under clause (3) the candidate shall faithfully, diligently and with skill and ability perform his/her duties and observe the rules for the time being in force made by the Governor or the President as the case may be for regulating the conduct of Government Servants.
4. The seat vacated by the Candidate on re-allocation and subsequently **if the seat is filled before the last date of admission as directed by the DCI is Rs.10,000/-**(Service Charge).
5. The seat is resigned by the Candidate and subsequently **if the seat is filled before the last date of admission as directed by the DCI is Rs.10,000/-** (Service Charge).
6. The seat vacated / resigned by the student after Counselling period and **the seat is not filled before the last date of admission as directed by the DCI is Rs.15,89,370/-** (Bond Breakage fee Rs.3,00,000/- + First year fee Rs.3,50,370/- + Remaining fee for the entire programme Rs. 9,39,000/-).

7. **Penalty**, in case candidates resigns after final round of AIQ / State Counselling is **Rs.15,89,370/-** (Bond Breakage fee Rs.3,00,000/- + First year fee Rs.3,50,370/- + Remaining fee for the entire programme Rs.9,39,000/-)
8. Any sum falling due from the candidate under this agreement shall be recovered from him/her as an arrear of land revenue.
9. If any dispute shall arise between the parties hereto in respect of this agreement or any of the provisions herein contained or anything arising hereunto except in respect of matters on which decision made by the Annamalai University Final and binding, the same shall be referred to the arbitration of Annamalai University whose decision thereon shall be final and binding on the parties.
10. The witness shall bear the stamp duty payable in respect of this agreement if required. In witness whereof the parties hereto have appended their signature hereunto on the dates respectively mentioned against the signature.
