The Dean instructed the committee members to perform the following activities for the academic year 2024-25


- Awareness campaign should be conducted to all batches of first year students to explain the objectives and functions of anti-ragging committee.

- 5. "Let's Join Hands to Stop Ragging".


















The various competitions conducted by the Department of Civil Engineering on the Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme are as follows:


TAMIL ELOCUTION:


TAMIL ESSAY WRITING:


