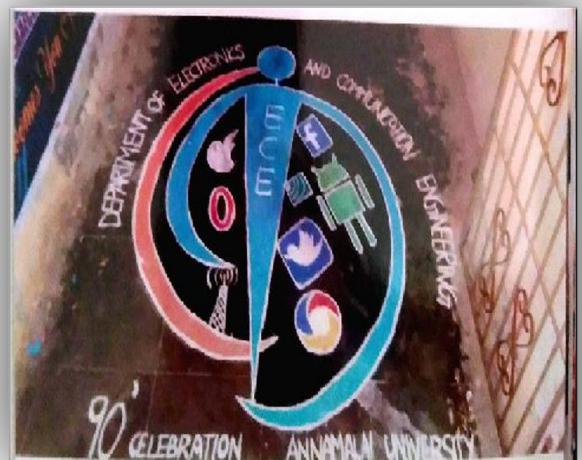

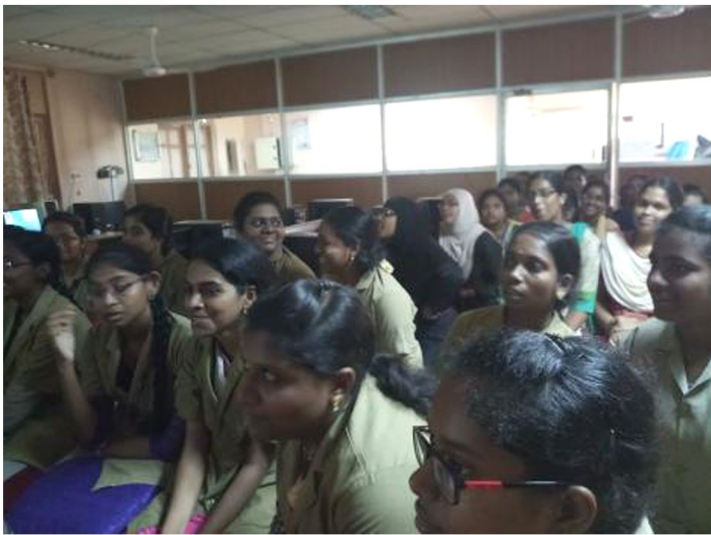
Technical Seminar:

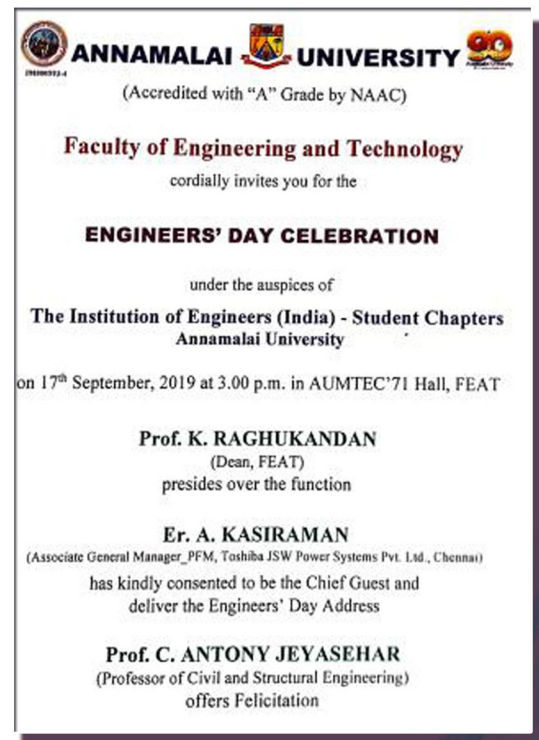
Essay Writing:
